The Doctorate in Philosophy at Roma Tre offers doctoral students other activities by making use of the skills and structures of the Department and the University, as well as collaboration agreements with CNR.

Laboratory and research activities, inter-disciplinary, multi-disciplinary and trans-disciplinary training.



Laboratory Activities

Laboratory activities are planned as compulsory in the first and second year of the PhD program for experimental linguistic-cognitive research of the Analytical Philosophy and Empirical Sciences curriculum. The activities take place in the Departmental CosmicLab (Cognition, Social Multimodal Interaction & Communication Laboratory). The Laboratory has a multidisciplinary experience in research, through the joint work of researchers from the Department and external collaborators from Italian and foreign universities. The CosmicLab's main focus of interest is the investigation of communication and language from a cognitive and neuroscientific perspective. Specifically, the laboratory's research focuses on a peculiar dimension of forms of human interaction and human communication, namely the narrative dimension, with the aim of exploring its cognitive and neural correlates by combining theoretical methods and state-of-the-art experimental approaches.

Activities at CNR

On the basis of the Agreement with ISMED-CNR of Naples, the Doctorate in Philosophy of Roma Tre guarantees doctoral students in the History of Philosophy and Critical Thinking the attendance of facilities and consultation of the ISMED Archives for research in political-social and environmental philosophy and in particular for doctoral research programs aimed at the innovation and technology transfer of theoretical and scientific-experimental research in the field of sociopolitical and economic studies of the environment, in geopolitical research and/or science policy (Art. 2 para.a and para. 2a of the Convention). The Convention also provides for co-supervisors in the case of interdisciplinary research in the area of the Environmental Humanities.

On the basis of the Agreement with ILIESI - CNR of Rome, the Doctorate in

Philosophy at Roma Tre guarantees access to scientific facilities and the use of the high scientific qualification made available to ILIESICNR in the fields of the history of philosophical and scientific ideas and lexical structures from antiquity to the contemporary age, in the fields of philology and textual hermeneutics, as well as digital methodologies for the analysis and processing of text corpora; the establishment of databases and infrastructures for humanistic research and the digital humanities. Doctoral students in the two curricula can therefore acquire highly specialized highly specialized skills for carrying out research programs doctoral programs in the field of the history of ideas and the study of terminology of culture, in particular philosophy; of the methodology of research in the history of philosophical and scientific thought; of the tools of digital scholarship in the humanities (Art. 2 a of the Convention). The Convention provides for also Co-Supervisors of research in the field of the history of ideas from antiquity to contemporaneity and/or modern scientific thought.

Linguistic improvement

The PhD course in Philosophy guarantees doctoral students in the two curricula language courses organized by the University Language Centre.



by the Centro Linguistico di Ateneo (Roma Tre, website: http://www.cla.uniroma3.it) to refine language skills in language skills in English and other European languages according to the needs of their research. For doctoral students, the language course is available only once and can be attended in the first year or second year of the course.

From the 2019/2020 academic year, the University Language Centre will be offering a course in Academic/Scientific English for PhD students who already have a B2 level. already in possession of the B2 level. The course offers support in the drafting of documents or in preparing for the oral presentation of studies and results of doctoral research. The Centro Linguistico d'Ateneo also organizes also organizes courses for the IELTS English language certification, developed by the consortium consisting of the British Council, IDP: IELTS Australia and Cambridge Assessment English.

IT improvement

Computer training focuses on training for consulting the most important international electronic platforms of philosophical and interdisciplinary books and journals. The training of doctoral students in the two curricula is provided by the 'Petrocchi' Humanities Library - Università Roma Tre. Periodic participation in the "Study Days" organised by the Sistema bibliotecario d'Ateneo (SBA-Roma Tre), entitled "Le chiavi di accesso alla ricerca. Presentation of paper and electronic library resources and services for doctoral students".

Management of research and knowledge of European and international research systems

In collaboration with the Research Office of the Department of Philosophy, Communication, Entertainment, the Doctorate in Philosophy organises meetings periodic meetings in the second and third year of the doctoral course with the Office Community Projects Office (UPC - site: https://uniroma3.sharepoint.com/UPC/SitePages/Pagina%20iniziale.aspx.

Valorization and dissemination of results, of the intellectual property and open access to the data and research products

For the valorization, dissemination of results and for the valorization of open access to research data, the PhD in Philosophy of Roma Tre promotes the dissemination of information on the most important online archives where preprints can be published. For the dissemination of scientific results, the PhD in Philosophy of Roma Tre has established editorial relationships with Carocci editore and with Mimesis International and collaborations with foreign and Italian journals of Band



A (Paradigmi. Rivista di critica filosofica- Mulino editore); for the open access dissemination of scientific results, the PhD in Philosophy of Roma Tre has established relationships with Italian scientific journals (B@bel on line) and Band A (Lebenswelt; Method. International Studies in Phenomenology and Philosophy). As part of the dissemination of research, the following are planned Organizations of study days, workshops, national and international conferences in collaboration with public or private, national or international research institutions, with doctoral contributions aimed at publication in specialized journals or collective volumes through double blind peer review procedures.

Fundamental principles of ethics, equality of gender equality and integrity

Experts from the CUG (Comitato Unico di Garanzia for Equal Opportunities, occupational well-being and against all forms of discrimination of the University of Roma Tre) will organize informative meetings for the first year of the doctoral course on the fundamental principles of ethics, gender equality and integrity, and equal opportunities. The meetings are scheduled in the first year of the course and will cover basic civic education, gender legal culture and the rights/duties relationship in public administration.

Seminar activities of assessment

Transition Days: PhD students present the state of the art of their research in front of the entire Doctoral College (Italian and foreign component). Together with the evaluation of the training and research plans, the papers for the first and second year doctoral courses, this annually recurring test constitutes a criterion for admission to subsequent years. The seminar is scheduled for transitions from first year to the second year and from the second year to the third year. The languages used may be Italian, English, French.

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
