1° year

Mandatory activities

- Attendance of two doctoral courses to be chosen from those offered by the Doctoral College in Philosophy University of Roma Tre.
- Drafting of two dissertations relating to the chosen doctoral courses.
- Participation in the "Doctoral Days" (International Study Days dedicated to the presentation of topics and research by doctoral students).
- Passing of the year:
 - Evaluation of the dissertations by the Members of the College of the Università degli Studi Roma Tre doctoral program.
 - Exposition of the research pathway to the Doctoral College Università degli Studi Roma Tre.

Optional activities

- Doctoral students may participate in all training activities planned by the Board of teachers.
- The doctoral college positively assesses the organization and/or presentation of papers by doctoral students at workshops summer/winter schools, study seminars, national and international conferences.

2° year

Mandatory activities

- Attendance at a seminar to be chosen from those offered by the College of Philosophy (Classics Reading Seminars or Thematic Seminars).
- Writing a thesis related to the chosen seminar or an article to be submitted for peer review.
- Participation in the 'Doctoral Days' (international study days dedicated to the presentation of doctoral candidates' topics and research).
- **Passing the year:**
 - Evaluation of the paper and/or consideration of the result of the peer review by the Members of the University of Roma Tre Doctoral College.
 - Exposition of the research pathway to the Doctoral board.

3° year

Mandatory activities

- Drafting of the three-yearly report on educational and scientific activities with an indication of any publications.
